Mayor Burriss called the regularly scheduled meeting of the Trenton City Council to order. Alderman Gibson led the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Those present for the meeting were Alderman Gibson, Hammonds, Jackson, Wade, Abbott and Overall. City employees present were Terry Bailey, Ricky Bailey, Barry Green, Will Sanders, Scott Dahlstrom, and Leigh Reynolds. Visitors present were Lanny Poteet and Crystal Burns.

Alderman Hammonds made a motion to approve the minutes of the November 12, 2013 council meeting. Alderman Overall seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RECORDER'S REPORT

City Recorder Leigh Reynolds presented 3 bids for a 2014 F350 truck for the Street Department. Bids were Steve Marsh Ford \$22,793.76, Chuck Graves \$28,660.00 and Gene Langley Ford \$21,610.00. Alderman Hammonds made a motion to purchase street truck from Gene Langley Ford for \$21,610.00 with TML borrowed money. Alderman Jackson seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

2ND READING ORDINANCE #284 MUNICIPAL FLOODPLAIN ZONING ORDINANCE
