Mayor Burriss called the regularly scheduled meeting to the Trenton City Council to order, led the invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.

Those present for the meeting were Alderman Gibson, Hammonds, Jackson, Wade, and Overall. City employees present were Terry Bailey, Ricky Bailey, Terry Brown, Barry Green, Will Sanders, Scott Dahlstrom, Richard Gossum, Corey Kesterson, and Leigh Reynolds. Alderman Wade made a motion to approve the minutes of the January 28, 2014 council meeting. Alderman Hammonds seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RECORDER'S REPORT

City Recorder Leigh Reynolds reported the expenditures for the month. Alderman Hammonds made a motion to pay expenditures with general fund expenses being \$67,380.11 and sanitation \$3,898.31. Alderman Overall seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

BARRY GREEN/FIRE DEPARTMENT

Chief Green stated that ISO will come on April 15, 2014 to do a survey which will last 2 or 3 hours. The fire department rating is a 5 now.

WILL SANDERS/POLICE DEPARTMENT

Chief Sanders stated that the department has been working on credibility program for 6 to 7 months; this is a 3 year program with certain benchmarks.

Chief Sanders informed the council of the E citation progress. There will be a conference call tomorrow morning with he and Brenda Ward discussing our software and TBI audit report returned and the department is in good shape with NCIC.

SCOTT DALSTROM/LIGHT & WATER DEPARTMENT

Scott gave a report on the AMI project stating with our own forces they have changed out 15 or so commercial electric meters.

Alderman Wade stated there was a tree on 919 South College that needed to come down.


MAYOR'S REPORT
