Alderman Wade made a motion to approve the minutes of January 13, 2015 council meeting. Alderperson Leadbetter seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RECORDER'S REPORT

RESOLUTION FOR ENGINEERING SERVICE 2015-R-3
