Mayor Jackson opens the public hearing for pro or con on Ordinance #315 to amend the Official Zoning Map to adopt Historic Zoning. Ricky Bailey stated that the historic district areas are 1st to 7th Street, High, College, and Church Streets. The areas have been on the Historic District National Register since 1982 and we would like to preserve this. Mayor Jackson Closed the public hearing at 6:05pm.
