Present as visitors were Gary Smith, Corbin Gibson, Lynn Cole, and James Ganaway.

A motion was made by Alderman Cannon to approve the minutes of the January 26<sup>th</sup> meeting. The motion was seconded by Alderman Jackson. The motion was passed by all. A motion was made by Alderman Overall to approve the minutes of the February 3<sup>rd</sup> called meeting. Alderman Hammonds seconded the motion. The motion was passed by all.

#### RECORDER'S REPORT

City Recorder, Sammy Dickey, presented the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month bills. They were General Fund \$14,670.24, Sanitation \$15,361.27, Electric Department \$668,610.90, Water and Sewer \$26,243.48.
