Alderman Hammonds made a motion to approve the minutes of April 9, 2013 meeting but would like the newspaper article to be attached to the minutes discussing the YMCA pledge. Alderman Wade seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TRENTON LIGHT AND WATER DEPARTMENT  
DESIGNATING ITS VOTING REPRESENTATIVE TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF

Alderman Wade made a motion to pass resolution 2013 R-4 appointing Mayor Burriss as the representative on the Board of Directors of Western District. Alderman Gibson seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**ORDINANCE #282-AMEND THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP**

Alderman Hammonds made a motion to pass 1<sup>st</sup> reading on ordinance #282 to amend the official zoning map of Trenton, TN rezoning the herein described property located along U.S. Hwy 45 By-Pass from R-4 (Density Residential) to B-2 (Intermediate Business). Alderman Abbott seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

**DONATION REQUEST FOR DESTINATION IMAGINATION**

The Destination Imagination team from Trenton Elementary advanced to the 2013 Global finals and are asking for a donation from the City of Trenton. The cost to get to the Global is \$10,000.

Alderman Abbott made a motion to donate \$500.00 to Destination Imagination for Global Competition. Alderman Hammonds seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

### **RECEIVE LAND FROM INDUSTRIAL BOARD**

The property on 1465 Industrial Park Drive owned by Maclean has a pumping station owned by Maclean, water tank owned by TL&W and land that the tank is on is owned by the Industrial Board. The Industrial Board does not want the land and wants the City to take possession. The Industrial Board voted in their last meeting to give it to the City.

Alderman Hammonds made a motion to accept the land where the water tank is located on 1465 Industrial Park Drive. Alderman Wade seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.
