The regularly scheduled meeting of the Trenton City Council was called to order and the invocation was given by Alderman Overall. Mayor Burriss welcomed everyone to the meeting and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Those present for the meeting were Alderman Gibson, Hammonds, Jackson, Wade and Overall. City employees present were Ricky Bailey, Terry Brown, Barry Green, Scott Dahlstrom, and Leigh Reynolds. Visitors present were Lanny Poteet, Danny Jones and Myra Elam.

Alderman Hammonds made a motion to approve the minutes of May 14, 2013 as distributed. Alderman Jackson seconded the motion. The motion carried by voice vote.

RECORDER'S REPORT

City Recorder Leigh Reynolds informed the council that Telecom Audit Group will start on the phone audit May 30, 2013.

GIBSON GENERAL HOSPITAL

Mayor Burriss stated that Gibson General in Trenton has had a declining amount of business and January 1, 2014 there will be a major change. The hospital and emergency room will be closed and replaced with a medical center offering primary care with walk-in after-hours care, post discharge follow-up patient care, screening, on-site lab and X-ray. The health care board of trustees stated that their goal is for no employee to lose their job.
