A regular scheduled meeting of the Trenton City Council was called to order by Mayor Tony Burriss. The invocation was given was given by Alderman Abbott. Mayor Burriss welcomed all in attendance and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Those present were elected officials, Alderman Abbott, Cannon, Gibson, Hammonds, Jackson, and Overall. City employees present were Sammy Dickey, Will Sanders, Barry Green, Terry Bailey, Ricky Bailey, and Bret Fisher. Visitors present were Danny Jones, Darryl Word, George and Carolyn Wade.

SAMMY DICKEY / CITY RECORDER

Sammy Dickey, City Recorder, reported the 10th of the month bills. They were General Fund \$24,047.15, Sanitation \$11,356.94, Electric Department \$585,658.02, and Water and Sewer \$80,476.02. Alderman Jackson made a motion to pay the bills. Alderman Hammonds made a second motion. The motion was passed by all.

CUTS AND EXCAVATIONS ORDINANCE #262

Alderman Cannon gave a motion to pass the second and final reading to pass Ordinance #262. The ordinance is designed to assure that the pavement, sidewalk, curb, and gutter is replaced the way it was originally. Alderman Hammonds gave a second motion. The motion was passed by all.

OPEN RECORDS RESOLUTION #2008-R-7

The Opens Records Resolution is a state mandated open records law. Resolution #2008-R-7 established procedures for public inspection of, access, to and duplication of public records. Alderman Hammonds made a motion to pass the resolution. Alderman Overall made a second motion. The motion was passed by all.

BARRY GREEN / FIRE DEPARTMENT

Barry reported to council that the new fire truck is going to Memphis for work and will be out of service for about a week.

WILL SANDERS / POLICE DEPARTMENT

Will recommended the hiring of Nick Milan as a patrolman. Nick is leaving the fire department to become a police officer. Alderman Hammonds gave motion to hire Nick as a patrolman. Alderman Gibson gave a second motion. Will also reported to council that Samora Hall, Nick Milan, and Mark Meadows will leave in January for the Police Academy.

BRET FISHER / LIGHT AND WATER DEPARTMENT

Bret reported to council that the Utility Department has a very serious problem with the roof leaking. It must be fixed but will wait until spring to start the repairs.

OTHER BUSINESS

Alderman Jackson thanked everyone for their help and attendance at the Christmas Party.

Alderman Overall expressed concern over cars in town that look like police cars. He stated that most are old police cars and that all the cities are having this problem.

Mayor Burriss reminded everyone of the City Stew. It will be December 18th from 11:00 to 1:00.

Mayor Burriss also reminded council that there will be a Beer Hearing at 1:00, December 18, 2008 after the stew. It will be the last meeting of 2008.

Mayor Burriss thanked everyone for their help with the Christmas Party.

Mayor Burriss also stated that the Sanitation bill was just over \$10,000 for the month as compared to \$14,000 to \$15,000 a month in the past.
