A regular scheduled meeting of the Trenton City Council was called to order by Mayor Tony Burriss. The invocation was given by Alderman Gibson. Mayor Burriss welcomed all in attendance and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Those present were elected officials, Alderman Abbott, Cannon, Gibson, Hammonds, Jackson, and Overall. City employees present were Bret Fisher, Sammy Dickey, Will Sanders, Barry Green, Terry Bailey, Ricky Bailey, Terry Brown, Jenny Corbin, and Ron Bennett. Danny Jones was present as a visitor.

RESOLUTION #2009-R-10

Alderman Cannon made a motion to approve Resolution #2009-R-10 for the Neighborhood Stabilization Program. They will administer an additional \$84,629. NSP is already administering a \$256,000 portion of the Community Development Block grant, making the total \$340,629. Alderman Hammonds seconded the motion. The motion was passed by all.

OCTOBER BOARD CONFERENCE

Mayor Burriss recommends a meeting for himself and the Council for discussion of several matters. It will be scheduled for October 21, 2009 from 8:00 – 12:00 in the council room.

RECYCLING KICKOFF

Doxicom's Recycling Kickoff is scheduled for Saturday, October 17, to coincide with Music on the Square with the first recycling pickups to begin the following Monday.

RICKY BAILEY / BUILDING INSPECTOR

Ricky reported to council that the Neighborhood Stabilization Grant has sent out 26 letters with 8 responses from property owners to allow them torn down.

WILL SANDERS / POLICE DEPARTMENT

Will informed council that he has been notified of a grant in the amount of \$208,000 the department has received for 2 resource officers. One will be placed at Peabody High School and the other will be at Trenton Rosenwald Middle School. Chief Sanders will set up a panel to help make the decision about which officers that would like to have in the schools. He said that he hopes to have the program in service by January 2010.

BRET FISHER / LIGHT AND WATER DEPARTMENT

Bret made the recommendation to council to approve the low bid of \$18,300 by Power and Generation Testing for sub-station testing. Alderman Hammonds made a motion to accept the low bid. Alderman Abbott seconded the motion. The motion was passed by all.

OTHER BUSINESS

Mayor Burriss informed council that Rob Goad wants to know if we want to apply for Phase 2 of the Downtown Grant. He does not know if we will have the match. Mayor Burriss wants to know if we want to apply and we can always refuse the grant if we don't have the match. Alderman Hammonds made the motion to apply for the grant and back out if we don't have the match. Alderman Jackson seconded the motion. The motion was passed by all.

Ace Hardware will have a grand Re-Opening on October 9th.

With no other business Alderman Hammonds made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:52 p.m. Alderman Jackson seconded the motion. The motion was passed by all.
